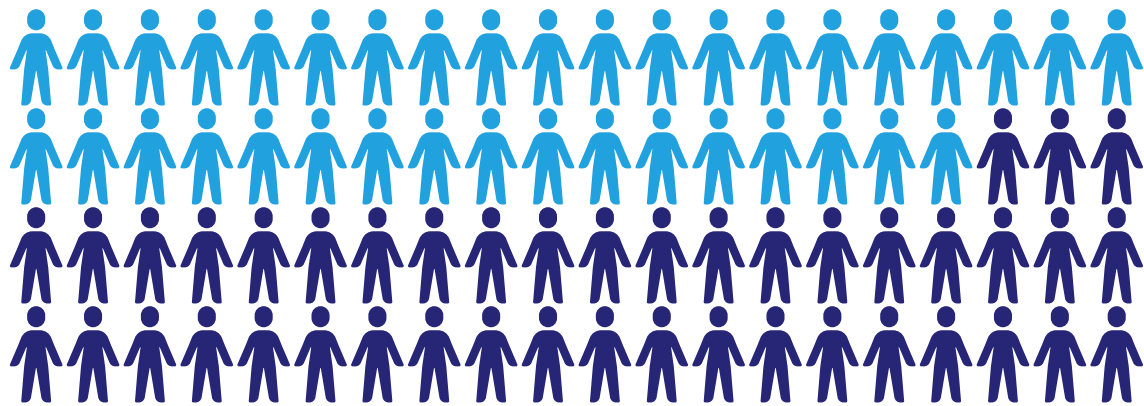

Why Meat?

Proper nutrition is vital to the growth and development of children and the health of all Hoosiers.

225,750 children in Indiana regularly experience food insecurity.

Protein is one of the most important nutrients for brain and body development, but also the hardest commodity for food banks to obtain.

Only 3-to-7% of available food at Indiana food banks is classified as meat, fish, or poultry.

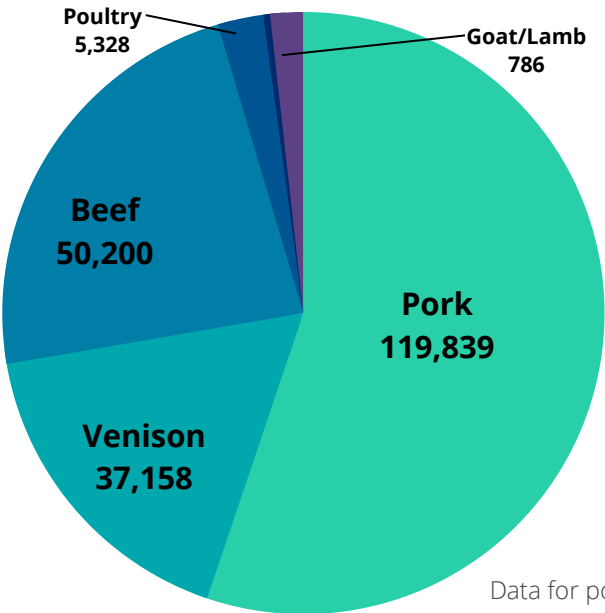

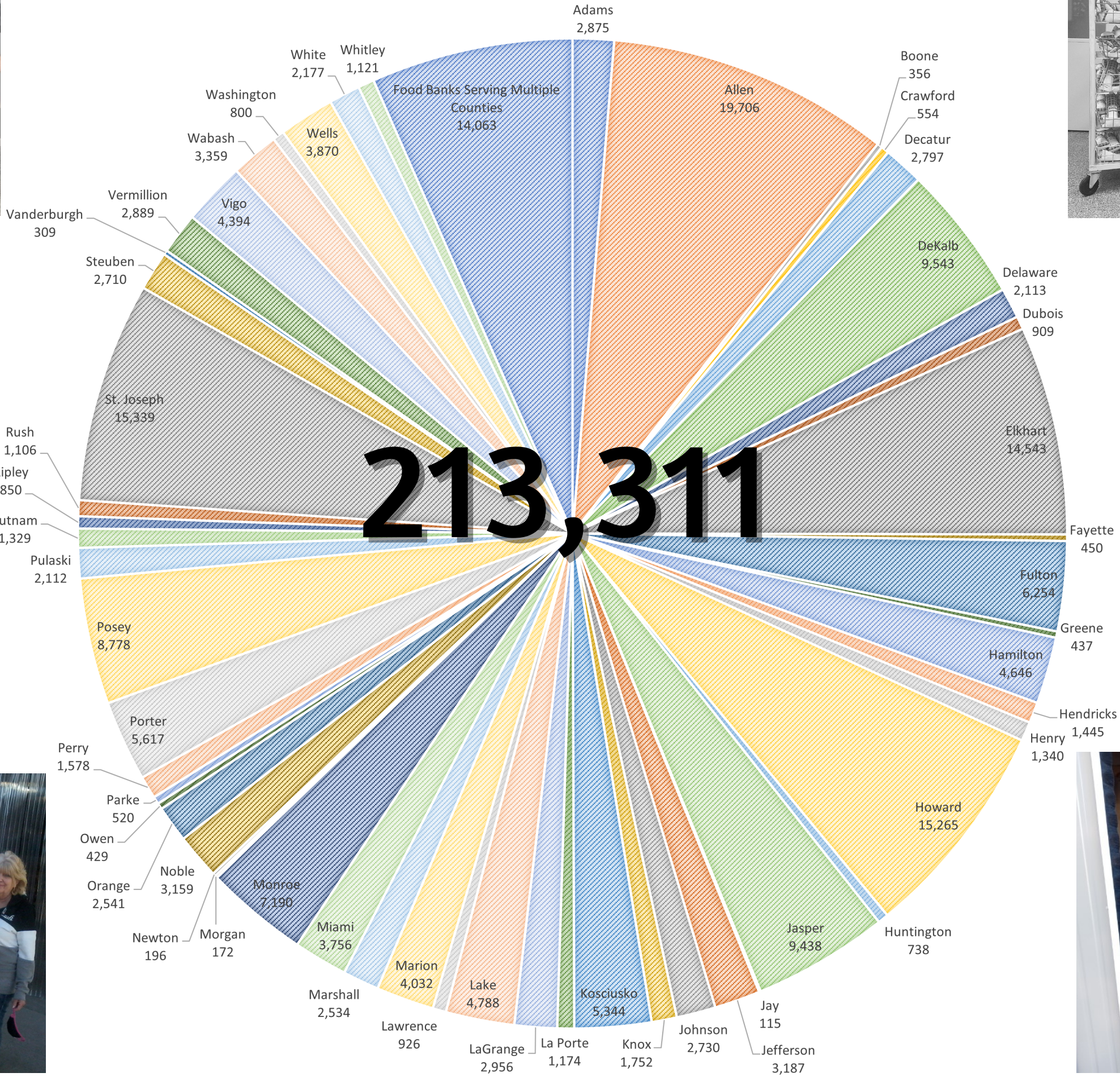
